Step 1: Understand your risk

You may be at increased risk of developing esophageal disease if you have 3 or more of the following risk factors:

- ☐ Chronic GERD
- ☐ Age over 50
- ☐ Male *Female*
- ☐ White Race
- ☐ Smoker
- ☐ Obesity
- ☐ Family History of Esophageal Precancer or Cancer
- ☐ Occupational or Environmental Exposure (smoke inhalation/fire/chemicals)

Step 2: See if EsoGuard is right for you

If you have 3 or more risk factors, complete the form supplied at an informational session.

Step 3: Schedule your in-person screening appointment

If the EsoGuard test is ordered for you, contact your organization to schedule your screening day appointment.
